**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ARCADE CREEK
RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT ADOPTING THE
CALIFORNIA CHILDREN'S OUTDOOR BILL OF RIGHTS**

WHEREAS, numerous studies document that children who do these things are healthier, do better in school, have better social skills and self-image, and lead more fulfilled lives, strengthen family relationships, and learn to be stewards of nature' and

WHEREAS, the California Children's Outdoor Bill of Rights has been drafted to draw attention to and encourage participation in ten beneficial outdoor activities that include: discover California's past, splash in the water, play in a safe place, camp under the stars, explore nature, learn to swim, play on a team, follow a trail, catch a fish, and celebrate their heritage; and

WHEREAS, the Arcade Creek Recreation and Park District Board of Directors intends that every child should have the opportunity to experience each of the activities listed within the California Children's Outdoor Bill of Rights by the end of their 14th year.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Arcade Creek Recreation and Park District adopts the California Children's Outdoor Bill of Rights and urges its citizens to participate in outdoor recreational opportunities.
