



### The Mission

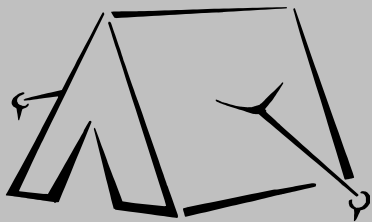
To encourage California's children to participate in outdoor activities and discover their heritage.

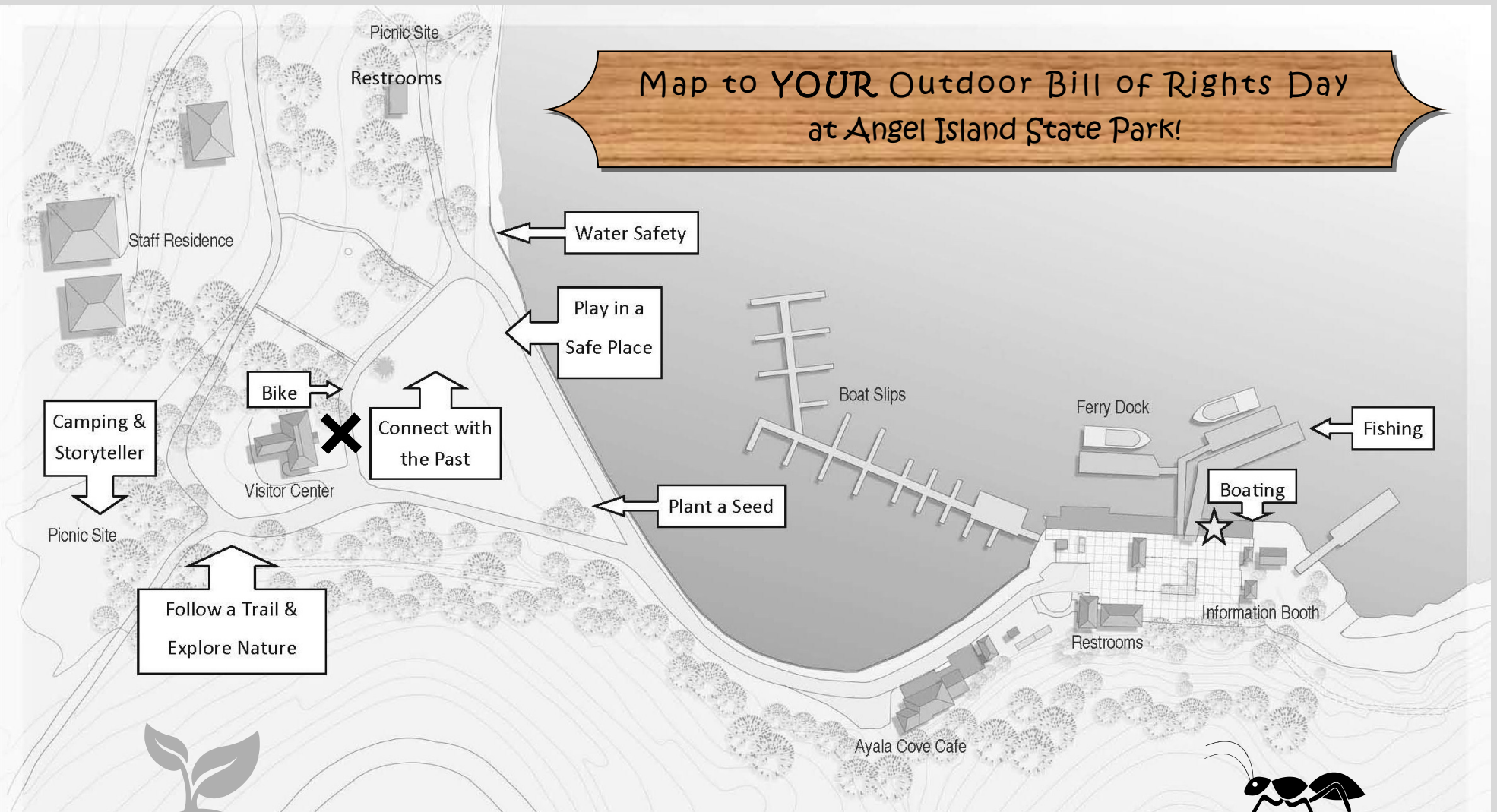
